

HIGHLANDS AT MANZANITA HOA ARC BUILDER PROCESS

Here is the process for a builder to work through the Highlands at Manzanita HOA Architectural Design Review Committee:

- 1. Download the CC&Rs/HOA Bylaws and ARC Guidelines documents at www.highlandsatmanzanita.com/resources/
- 2. Review those documents to understand what is and isn't allowed. If you have any questions, please contact Rick Hinkes, rjh97034@yahoo.com or 503-706-0196.
- 3. Fill out the ARC Approval form attached to this document. Please fill it out as completely as you can and include all requested documents. We understand the cosmetic items such as paint colors, flooring, etc may be selected later. You will receive conditional approval and must submit those items <u>before</u> proceeding with that portion of the build.
- 4. Review the streetlight and driveway standard, HAM001, attached to this document. That must be a part of your build, per City of Manzanita requirements. You must follow the standard exactly, including the fixture, pole, height and location specified.
- 5. You must have a signed ARC approval form before proceeding with any work on the property. Once your form is completed or amended, send it and all attachments to the HOA at highlandsatmanzanitahoa@gmail.com. We will return as soon as possible.
- 6. Once construction has started, the city requires the utility easement, the first 8' back from the street, be kept clean and clear. In addition, all runoff sand and water should be kept confined to the property via silt fence, manual clean up or other means. See the attached sketch for details.
- 7. TRASH MUST BE CLEANED FROM THE LOT WEEKLY and kept off the utility easement and out of sight of neighbors and visitors to Highlands. We suggest using a dumpster, but not to be placed in the utility easement!
- 8. IMPORTANT: Any change or addition to your design that isn't consistent with your original submittal must be approved prior to implementing that change/addition. Use the design change form attached to this document.

This standard sets the type, size and location of individual light fixtures to be placed on all SeaView & Meadows Drive lots.

Location: Light poles to be located per sketch below — on the north side of the driveway on all lots east of SeaView & Meadows Drive and on the south side of the driveway on all lots west of SeaView & Meadows Drive.

Electrical: Fixture to be wired to unswitched circuit, controlled only by the photo cell.


Setting: Light poles to be set in 18" deep concrete, 12" diameter.


Height: Total height, including the fixture, to be no taller than 60". The pole specified is 7' long. Cut as necessary to achieve the 60" overall height and 18" below grade spec.

Fixture: Generation Lighting P/N OL 12807TXB-L1 LED Post Lantern (\$183.00/ea) Post: Generation Lighting P/N 8112-12 Aluminum Post with Photo Cell (\$114.00/ea)

NOTE: 45 degree angles on driveway entrance at apron required.
